REMOTE ABORIGINAL COMMUNITY CLOSURES ON THE DAMPIER PENINSULA

IMPORTANT: Due to COVID-19 and Section 67 of the Remote Aboriginal Communities Direction, Visitors to the peninsula are NOT PERMITTED to enter closed Aboriginal communities on the Dampier Peninsula, even by accident. There are severe penalties for anyone that breaches this direction, with fines of over \$50,000. This includes accessing the peninsula's beaches or nearby islands via boat.
